for Adoption.

1. REFERENCES:

a. 0.0. 473.85/537

2. DISCUSSION:

- a. Urgent requests have been received from overseas units for rifles equipped with telescopes for use by snipers. As a result of tests conducted by the Infantry Board, and manufacturing investigations conducted by the Ordnance Department, several M1903 rifles have been altered and fitted with commercial type telescopes.
- <u>b</u>. After examination of the Infantry Board Report and telescopes submitted by the Ordnance Department, Headquarters, Army Ground Forces with the concurrence of Headquarters, Services of Supply has recommended the following:
 - (1) "After weighing these considerations, and in the light of urgent requirements for a sniper's rifle for immediate issue to the field forces, it is recommended:
 - (a) "That the hunting type of telescope, as exemplified by the Weaver 330-C, be adopted as standard for the Sniper's rifle.
 - (b) "That the reticle be of the cross hair type, with medium weight cross hair, subtending not more than one minute of angle.
 - (c) "That the telescope be equipped with windage and elevation knobs similar to the weaver 330-C, and which indicates amounts of change by clicks.
 - (d) "That the telescope be mounted above the receivers of the M1903 or M1903Al Rifle initially, for immediate production.

- (e) "That the mount be fixed and permanent.
- (f) "That the rifles used be especially selected for accuracy and smoothness of operation, and with type "C" stocks if available; and that the bolt handles be so remodeled as to eliminate interference with the sight.
- (g) "That a project be undertaken at once to develop a side (left) mount for the sniper's telescope on the Ml rifle, but that this development be not allowed to interfere with production of Ml903 Sniper's rifles.
- (2) "It is recommended that the combination of the telescope recommended above, paragraph (1) a, and the M1903 or M1903Al Rifle, whichever is selected, be adopted standard as a Sniper's Rifle.
- (3) "The following basis of issue is recommended:

3. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a. In view of the foregoing this subcommittee recommends that:
- (1) the Weaver 330-C, the Lyman Alaskan or any other rifle telescope meeting specifications set forth in paragraph 2c, of the discussion, be adopted for use by snipers.
 - (2) telescopes be fitted to M1903Al rifles.
- (3) these rifles have the iron sights removed and be equipped with altered safeties, bolt handles and mounts similar to the Jr. -S Redfield Mount.
- (4) these rifles equipped with telescopes sights and altered as in paragraph (2) above, be known as U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30 M1903A4 (Spiners).
- <u>b</u>. It is also recommended that development of a side mounted telescopes sight for the ML Rifle be undertaken pursuant to instructions received from Army Ground Forces.
